Dear General

I am writing on behalf of the British Medical Association to express our grave concern with the continuing detention of Dr Tarek Loubani and his colleague, Professor John Greyson following the unrest in Ramsis Square on the 16th of August. I am writing to urge you to release Dr Loubani and Professor Greyson unless there is sufficient admissible evidence to try them before a civilian court in line with international standards of fair trials and without recourse to a death penalty. I would also urge that you continue to give both men full and free access to their lawyers, families and consular representatives.
