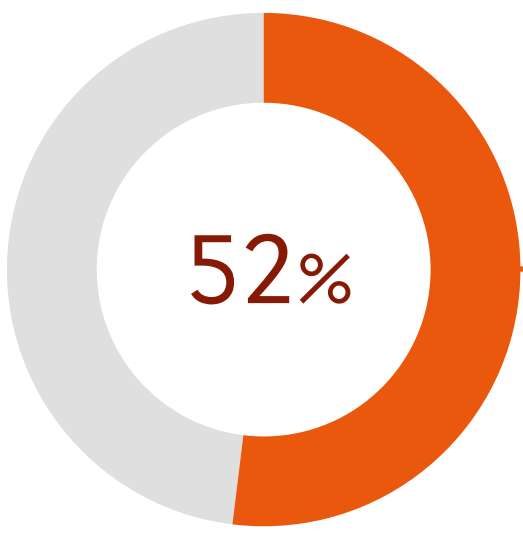


Best way to develop general practice in the future

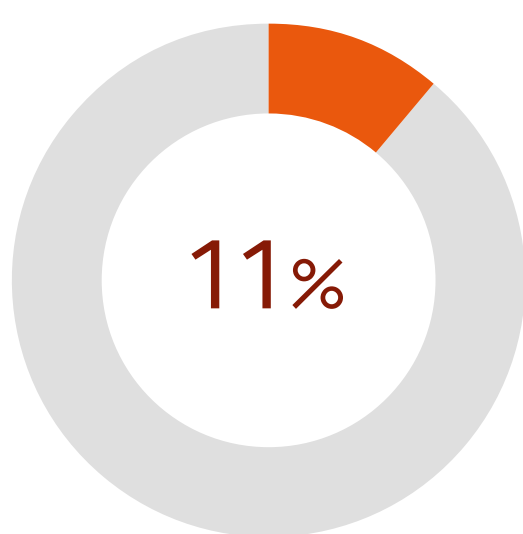
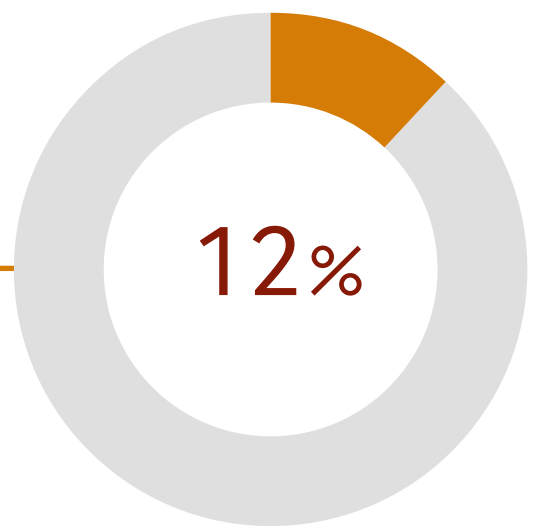


Collaboration

Over half (52%) think practices working more collaboratively with other professionals is most important

Non-urgent secondary care

Over one in ten (12%) think working in networks and taking on the running of some aspects of non-urgent secondary care is most important

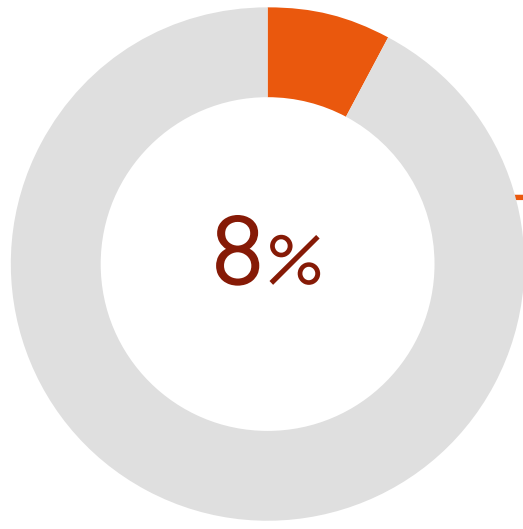
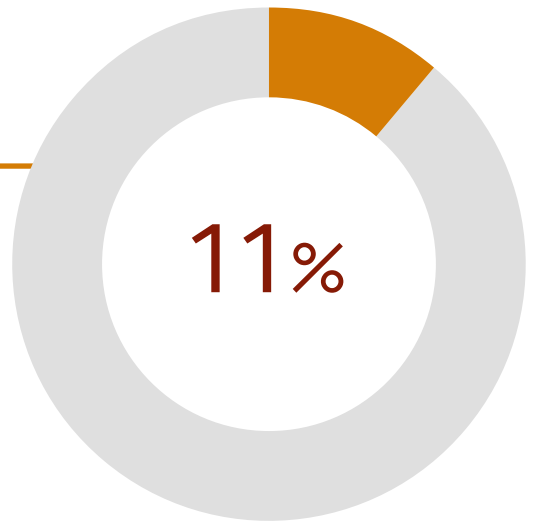


Working separately

11% think that the top priority should be practices that work as separate entities

GP-led organisations

Over one in ten (11%) think it is most important for GP-led organisations to deliver GP, hospital and mental health services within the same organisation



Working in networks

Hospital-led organisations
