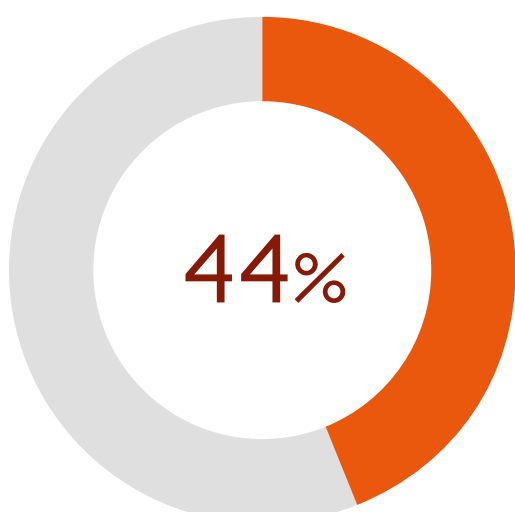
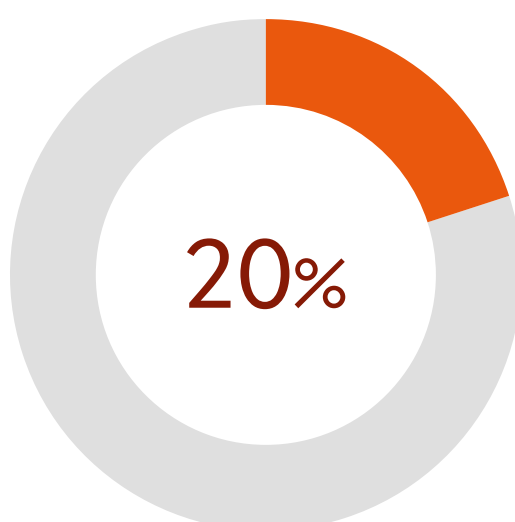
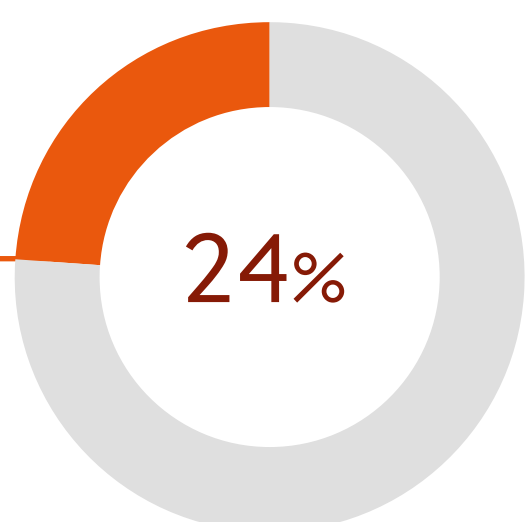


Figures show that for a high proportion of sessional GPs, working as a sessional GP is a positive career choice:



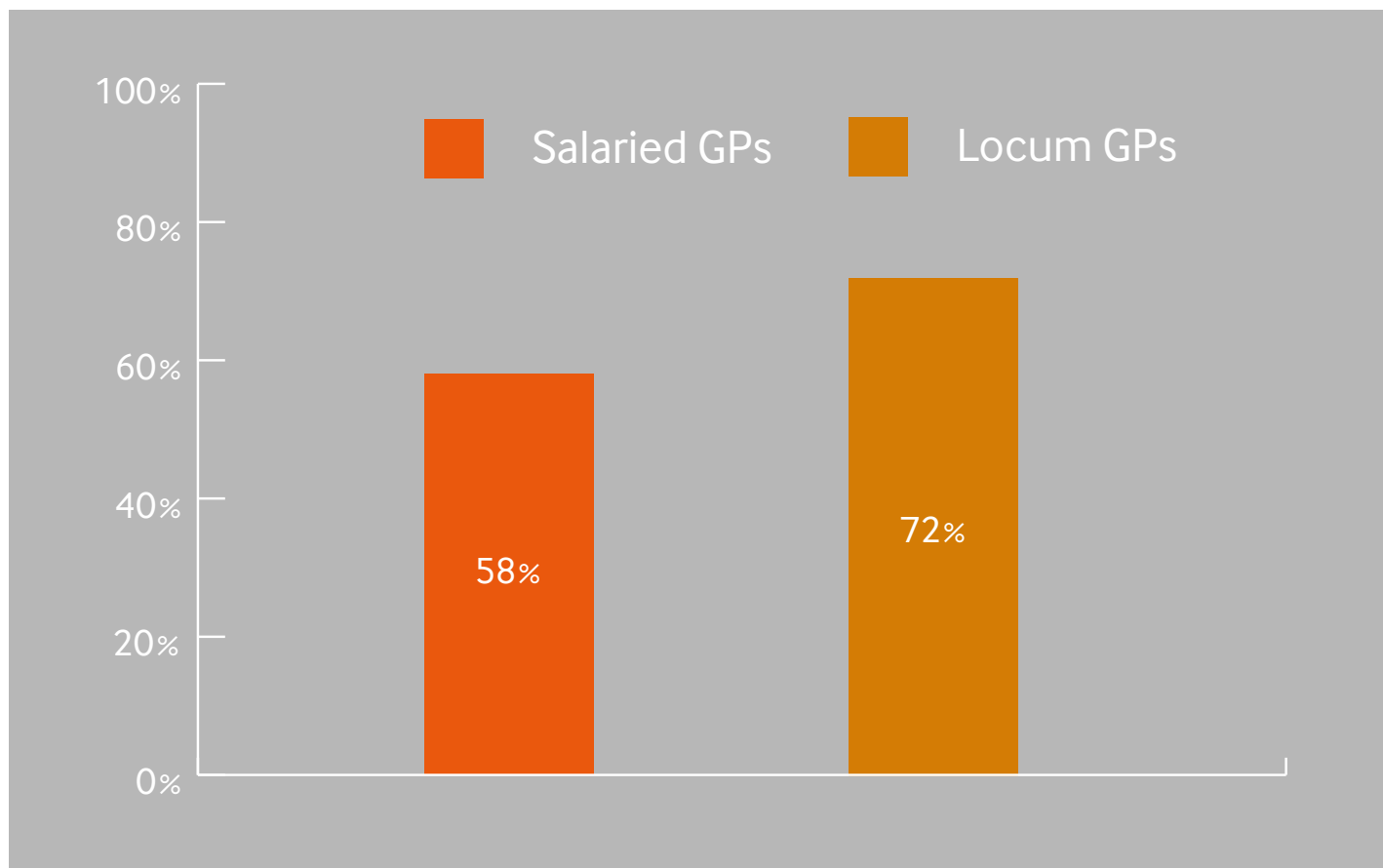
**44%** of practice employed salaried GPs want a partnership at some point in the future

**24%** of salaried GPs envisage looking for a partnership in the near future



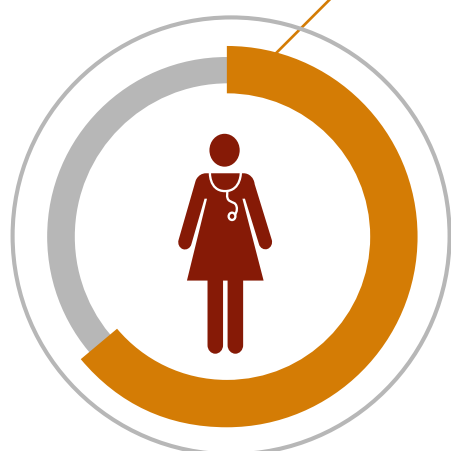
**20%** envisage this in the long term

When asked about their reasons for working as a sessional GP, the main reason given was the **flexibility** this role affords, or the desire for a good **work-life balance** (**58%** for salaried GPs, **72%** for locums)



**Almost two-thirds (64%)**

of sessional GPs say they do not envisage looking for a GP partnership in the future



**73%** of sessional GPs

aged 30 or under said they envisaged looking for a partnership at some point
