Competition Terms and Conditions

1 Promoter's name and address

The British Medical Association, BMA House, Tavistock Square, London, WC1H 9JP

2 How to participate

The competition is open to all BMA members over the age of 18 years. All entries must be supported by a completed entry form. Entries can be submitted in the following ways:

- i. Electronically by email to kcubbage@bma.org.uk
- ii. On a USB, CD or SD card by post to 5th Floor, 2 Caspian Point, Caspian Way, Cardiff Bay, Cardiff, CF10 4DQ.

All entries must include your name, email address, address (including postcode), telephone number and age. You must provide a photograph depicting the theme 'What being a doctor means to you'. Caption information supplied must be complete, true and accurate. Entrants should NOT INCLUDE their name in the caption or on the image itself to ensure an anonymous review is undertaken as part of the judging process. Any entry that cannot be authenticated, is incomplete or not of acceptable quality is void and will not be entered into the competition. You may submit three entries. Please complete one competition entry form per photograph.

3 Start and closing date

Entries shall be accepted where they are received by the promoter between 9am, Monday 10 April 2017 and 8am, Monday 8 May 2017.

4 Selection of the winner[s]

All entries will be judged and shortlisted by a panel of judges (including an independent judge). The names of the judges are available on request. Any entries found not to comply with these competition rules may be disqualified. Judges decision shall be final and no further correspondence shall be entered into. The winning entries may be published online or used in BMA publications.

5 Prize

Prizes will be awarded to the winner and runner up. A description of the prize is as follows:

Winner: Vouchers up to the value of £250
Runner up: Vouchers up to the value of £100

There is no alternative prize or cash equivalent. The prize is non-transferable.

6 Restrictions and requirements

Please note all entrants must be over the age of 18. Employees of the promoter and their immediate families are ineligible to enter this competition.

7 Notification of the results and receipt of the prizes

The promoter will notify the winners by email on or before Friday 2 June 2017. The winner will receive their prize on or before Wednesday 14 June.

8 Intellectual Property

8.1 By submitting an entry and in consideration of £1 you grant the promoter an exclusive, non-transferable, world-wide license to use your submitted photograph[s] ("Photographic Work") in electronic and hard copy format, and in all media. The licence includes the right to store, disclose, print, copy, reproduce, publish, market, distribute, sell, exhibit or otherwise use or exploit the Photographic Work.

8.2 The Photographic Work must be your own original work and not obscene, defamatory or in breach of any applicable laws. Where third party materials and/or content are used you must provide a copy of such written permissions to the BMA.

8.3 If the entrant is not the sole producer and copyright owner of the Photographic Work then written permissions obtained from any co-owner(s) must be provided to the BMA.

8.4 Entry into the competition does not grant you rights in any intellectual property of the BMA. You shall not use any names, logos or associated images of the BMA without our prior written consent.

9 Data Protection

9.1 Entrants must ensure full compliance with all applicable laws, including but not limited to, securing relevant permissions from anyone (data subjects) identified in the Photographic Work. Evidence of such permission must be made available to the BMA on request.

9.2 When dealing with personal data the BMA shall adhere to the Data Protection Act 1998.

10 General

10.1 Insofar as permitted by law the BMA excludes all liability for any loss or damage arising from the competition. Nothing in these terms and conditions will limit the promoter's liability for death or personal injury caused by its negligence or for fraud.

10.2 These terms and conditions shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales and any disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
