

Do you currently have adequate supplies or shortages of the following PPE when working in an AGP area?






Have you ever felt pressured when working in an AGP area to see a patient without adequate protection?







Taking everything into account, do you feel safely protected from coronavirus infection in your place of work?





Does your place of work or local NHS offer testing for hospital doctors?





What impact is self-isolation having in your place of work with regard to staffing capacity and workload?


